ARCHERY RULES

1 TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

- 1.1 The AUG archery competition will be organised in accordance with:
- 1.1.1 The AUG General Rules & Regulations.
 - 1.1.2 The current technical regulations of the World Archery Federation (WA).
- 1.2 The competition will consist of the following events:

- 1.3 Each country is authorised to enter:
- 1.3.1 A maximum of 8 men competitors, 8 women competitors and 5 team officials. Number of team officials shall not exceed number of competitors.
 - 1.3.2 Individual Events: Maximum of 4 competitors per event.
 - 1.3.3 Men & Women Team Events: For each men & women team event, maximum of 1 team of 3 competitors selected based on their best score in the individual qualification round.
 - 1.3.4 Mixed Team Events: For each mixed team event, maximum of 1 team of 2 competitors (1 man & 1 woman) selected based on their best scores in the individual qualification round.
- 1.4 Countries must confirm and submit their list of competitors at the General Technical Briefing.

2 COMPETITION REGULATIONS

- 2.1 Men & Women Team Events
- 2.1.1 If a country is unable to present a compound bow team for either men's or women's events, it shall be allowed to present a mixed team to compete in the men's compound bow event (1 man + 2 women, or 2 men + 1 woman). The selection criteria shall be determined by the competition rules.

2.1.2 The 8 best teams, each composed of 3 competitors selected by adding the best score of the 3 best competitors of the same country obtained in the individual qualification round, shall be able to compete. The competition format for this competition will be:

- A Recurve Bow: Academic Round with full target face, set system (see WA rules - Academic Round)
- B Compound Bow: Compound Round with full target face, cumulative scoring (see WA rules - Compound Round)

2.2 Mixed Team Events

2.2.1 The 8 best teams, each composed of 2 competitors (1 man & 1 woman) selected by adding the best score of the best man and best woman competitors of the same country obtained in the individual qualification round, shall be able to compete. The competition format for this competition will be:

- A Recurve Bow: Academic Round with full target face, set system (see WA rules - Academic Round)
- B Compound Bow: Compound Round with full target face, cumulative scoring (see WA rules - Compound Round)

2.2.2 To shoot in the elimination phase, the archers can be the same ones that make the qualification or any other ones that the delegation appoints. Once both archers are selected (deadline is before warm-up of the given competition starts), they shall not be replaced.

2.2.3 The selected man and woman must be from the same country and the same bow division.

2.3 System of Competition

2.3.1 This competition will consist of a FITA/WA Qualification Round and an Outdoor Olympic Round (Elimination and Final Round) for both recurve and compound bow divisions for men and women - 70m Rounds for recurve and 50m Rounds for compound.

2.3.2 Qualification Round

Each archer will shoot 72 arrows (2-36 arrows) in 12 ends of 6 arrows. The top 24 individuals, the top 8 men and women teams and the top 8 mixed teams selected based on the points of each archers from the Qualification Round shall advance to the Elimination Rounds. Only in positions of cut (24), one arrow shoots off will be arranged. If still a tie, then the arrow closest to the center of the target face will resolve the tie.

2.3.3 Individual Eliminations (1/12, 1/8) and Individual Finals (1/4, 1/2, Bronze & Gold)

The top 24 archers seeded according to their positions in the Qualification Round (check with match play chart) should shoot against each other with the winners moving onto the next round.

2.3.4 Men & Women Team Eliminations and Final (1/4, 1/2, Bronze & Gold)

The top 8 men and women teams will take part in the team eliminations and finals.

2.3.5 Mixed Team Eliminations and Final (1/4, 1/2, Bronze & Gold)

The top 8 mixed teams will take part in the Mixed Team eliminations and finals.

2.4 Draw

After the final entries have been received, the draw for target number and the shooting order will be held according to FITAWA rules. 3 archers will be assigned to each target.

2.5 Match Attire

The attire of participants must comply with FITA/WA standard.

2.6 Judge Commission

A Judge Commission will consist of a minimum of 2 FITA International Judges, and the number of NTOs shall be agreed between OC and AUG TD (Tech Com).

A judge's decision is final with respect to the value of an arrow in a target and must be resolved before any arrow could be removed.
