



# **ASEAN UNIVERSITY GAMES**

## **BADMINTON RULES**

### **1 TECHNICAL REGULATIONS**

- 1.1 The AUG badminton competition will be organised in accordance with:
- 1.1.1 The AUG General Rules & Regulations.
  - 1.1.2 The current technical regulations of the Badminton World Federation (BWF).
- 1.2 The competition will consist of the following:
- 1.2.1 Individual Events
    - A Men's Singles
    - B Men's Doubles
    - C Women's Singles
    - D Women's Doubles
    - E Mixed Doubles
  - 1.2.2 Team Events
    - A Men's Team (3 singles & 2 doubles)
    - B Women's Team (3 singles & 2 doubles)
- 1.3 Each country is authorised to enter:
- 1.3.1 A maximum of 7 men competitors, 7 women competitors and 5 team officials. Number of team officials shall not exceed number of competitors.
  - 1.3.2 Individual Events: Maximum of 2 entries per event. Each competitor may compete in a maximum of 2 individual events.
  - 1.3.3 Team Events: 1 team per event (maximum of 7 competitors and minimum of 4 competitors per team).

### **2 COMPETITION REGULATIONS**

- 2.1 Individual Events Competition Format - with 5 or less entries
- 2.1.1 Phase 1: A round robin league system shall be played in which the entries shall play against each other in a single group league to decide the ranking of the entries.
  - 2.1.2 Phase 2: The entries ranked 1st & 2nd will play the gold medal match and the entries ranked 3rd & 4th will play the bronze medal match.

- 2.2 Individual Events Competition Format - with 6 to 11 entries
- 2.2.1 The competition will be divided into 2 groups, Group A & Group B, in which the gold medal winner in the previous AUG badminton competition shall be seeded in Group A and the silver medal winner in Group B.
- 2.2.2 The host shall have the privilege in choosing the group and also the position in the group they wish to be in when the draw is made.
- 2.2.3 Care shall be taken to prevent placing the entries from the same country into the same group or bracket.
- 2.2.4 Phase 1: A round robin league system shall be played within the 2 groups in which the entries shall play against each other. The top 2 ranked entries of each group will advance to the semi-finals, and the rest of the entries will play in the classification matches, if applicable.
- 2.2.5 Phase 2: Semi-Finals: 1A vs 2B and 2A vs 1B.  
Finals: Semi-Finals winners will play the gold medal match and Semi-Finals losers will play the bronze medal match.
- 2.2.6 If there are 7 and less entries in the tournament, classification matches will be scheduled to determine 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> positions. This is to ensure that all entries get to play at least 3 matches in the tournament.
- 2.3 Individual Events Competition Format - with 12 and more entries
- 2.3.1 The competition will be divided into 4 groups, Group A, B, C and D in which the gold medal winner in the previous AUG badminton competition shall be seeded in Group A, the silver medal winner in Group B, the bronze medal winner in Group C and the 4<sup>th</sup> placed winner in Group D.
- 2.3.2 The host shall have the privilege in choosing the group and also the position in the group they wish to be in when the draw is made.
- 2.3.3 Care shall be taken to prevent placing the entries from the same country into the same group.
- 2.3.4 Phase 1: A round robin league system shall be played within the 4 groups in which the entries shall play against each other. The top 2 ranked entries of each group will advance to the quarter-finals and the rest of the entries will play in the classification matches, if applicable.
- 2.3.5 Phase 2: Quarter Finals: 1A vs 2D (QF1), 1B vs 2C (QF2), 1C vs 2B (QF3), 1D vs 2A (QF4).  
Semi-Finals: Winner QF1 vs Winner QF3, Winner QF2 vs Winner QF4.  
Finals: Semi-Finals winners will play the gold medal match and Semi-Finals losers will play the bronze medal match.
- 2.3.6 Classification matches will be scheduled to ensure that all entries get to play at least 3 matches in the tournament.

- 2.4 Team Events Competition Format - with 5 or less teams
- 2.4.1 Phase 1: A round robin league system shall be played in which the teams shall play against each other in a single group league to decide the ranking of the entries.
- 2.4.2 Phase 2: The teams ranked 1st & 2nd will play the gold medal match and the teams ranked 3rd & 4th will play the bronze medal match.
- 2.5 Team Events Competition Format - with 6 or more teams
- 2.5.1 The competition will be divided into 2 groups, Group A & Group B, in which the winner in the previous AUG badminton competition shall be seeded in Group A and the silver medal team in Group B.
- 2.5.2 The host shall have the privilege in choosing the group and also the position in the group they wish to be in when the draw is made.
- 2.5.3 Phase 1: A round robin league system shall be played within the 2 groups in which the teams shall play against each other. The top 2 ranked teams of each group will advance to the semi-finals, and the rest of the teams will play in the classification matches, if applicable.
- 2.5.4 Phase 2: Semi-Finals: 1A vs 2B and 2A vs 1B.  
Finals: Semi-Finals winners will play the gold medal match and Semi-Finals losers will play the bronze medal match.
- 2.5.5 If there are 7 and less teams in the tournament, classification matches will be scheduled to determine 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> positions. This is to ensure that all teams get to play at least 3 matches in the tournament.
- 2.6 Ranking of Entries/Teams in Phase 1 (Round Robin League Phase)
- 2.6.1 The following league points system will apply:
- |      |          |

| Win  | 2 points |
| Loss | 0 point  |
- 2.6.2 The ranking within the group is determined by the greater number of league points obtained in all group matches.
- 2.6.3 If 2 entries/teams ended phase 1 competition with a tie in league points, the winner of the match between these 2 entries/teams will be awarded the higher placing.
- 2.6.4 If 3 or more entries/teams ended phase 1 competition with a tie in league points, the following tie-breaking mechanism shall apply:
- A The match difference using results from matches only among the tied entries/teams
  - B The game difference using results from matches only among the tied entries/teams
  - C The point difference using results from matches only among the tied entries/teams
  - D The match difference using results from all matches

- E The game difference using results from all matches
- F The point difference using results from all matches

2.7 Match Attire

2.7.1 The attire of participants must comply with BWF standard.
