ROWING & TRADITIONAL BOAT

1 TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

1.1 The AUG Rowing & Traditional Boat competition will be organised in accordance with:

1.1.1 The AUG General Rules & Regulations.

1.1.2 The current technical regulations of the World Rowing Federation (FISA) and the International Dragon Boat Federation (IDBF).

1.2 The competition will consist of the following events:

1.3 Each country is authorised to enter:

1.3.1 A maximum of 26 men athletes (12 for rowing and 14 for Traditional Boat), 26 women athletes (12 for rowing and 14 for Traditional Boat) and 10 officials (5 for rowing and 5 Traditional Boat). Number of team officials shall not exceed number of athletes.

1.3.2 A maximum of 1 entry for each event only.

1.3.3 For Lightweight Double Scull and Four events, each entry may have 1 and 2 reserves respectively.

1.3.4 Minimum number of paddlers for each Traditional Boat event is 8 paddlers. The gender for the drummer and coxswain shall be the same as the paddlers except for the mixed event whereby the drummer and coxswain can be either male or female.

1.3.5 At least 4 women paddlers for the Mixed 10-Paddler Traditional Boat events; not including the drummer and coxswain.

1.3.6 Only Eight (8+) may be participated by double entries consisting of athletes from Single Scull, Lightweight Single Scull and Lightweight Double Scull and Four events. Traditional Boat may be participated by double entries.

- 1.4 Each country participating in the rowing events must bring with them 1 international FISA referee.

2 COMPETITION REGULATIONS

2.1 Competition Format

A total of 4 boats may participate in the finals. The following shall be the rowing competition format for each event:

4 Entries: Direct final

5 - 6 Entries: 2 heats will be conducted. The first in each heat will proceed to the final. The second and third from each heat will compete in the Repechage. The first and second in the Repechage will proceed to the final.

7 - 8 Entries: 2 heats will be conducted. The first in each heat will proceed to the final. The second, third and fourth from each heat will compete in the two Repechages. The first in each Repechage will proceed to the final.

9 – 10 Entries: 3 heats will be conducted. The first and second in each heat will proceed to the semi-finals. The third and fourth from each heat will compete in the Repechage. The first and second in the Repechage will proceed to the semi-finals. The first and second in the semi-finals will proceed to the final.

11 – 12 Entries: 3 heats will be conducted. The first and second in each heat will proceed to the semi-finals. The third and fourth from each heat will compete in 2 Repechages. The first in each Repechage will proceed to the semi-finals. The first and second in the semi-finals will proceed to the final.

2.2 Equipment

2.2.1 All boats shall be provided and allocated to individual teams at the sole discretion of the organizer.

2.2.2 The organizer will not be responsible for any failure of equipment during a race and each team is advised to carefully check the equipment before leaving the dispatch area.

2.2.3 Teams shall not change their boats or equipment after leaving the dispatch area.

2.2.4 All participants must bring their own paddles. Two spare paddles are allowed on the Traditional Boat.

2.2.5 Paddles must not have any tapes or any other foreign material.
